Sports Funding mid-year review March 2016

In 2014/15 the school spent a large sum of money on PE training for all the teaching staff. We invested in a complete new scheme of work and training for all teaching staff. The scheme has been very well received by staff and pupils, however we will be able to measure the true success of the new scheme as we move into the Summer Term and we can look at comparative achievement data with the end of last year.

This year so far has been a time of consolidation for the scheme and of teaching PE in school.

We are now looking to now invest in associated schemes particularly focused on Dance and Gymnastics. This will involve staff training and schemes being purchased for both Key Stages. To members of staff have already attended the Gymnastics course for Key Stage One.

Our other expenditure so far this year has been relatively light. We have used some funding for Training for one of our TAs to run a dance club. We also use some of the funding to pay for her to run the club and for an HLTA to run the 'Get Started' club to in the mornings.

We have funded equipment for lunchtimes and resources for the Northamptonshire 'Off the Couch' program and the Healthy Child Project.

Other spend has been on equipment for PE and Health and Safety checks on the current PE and Playground equipment.

This will give us a carry forward into the summer term. We will be spending a large sum on the new schemes and additional staff training plus equipment and further involvement and development of the school's Healthy Child Program.
