If your child does get upset as you drop off, please do not worry they are fine a couple of



Communication and Language: We will initiate conversations with each other and share our learning together.


Physical Development: We will learn how to be independent and put our coats on our pegs and our shoes/wellies on. **Literacy:** We will be exploring different ways we can make
