**SECURE**



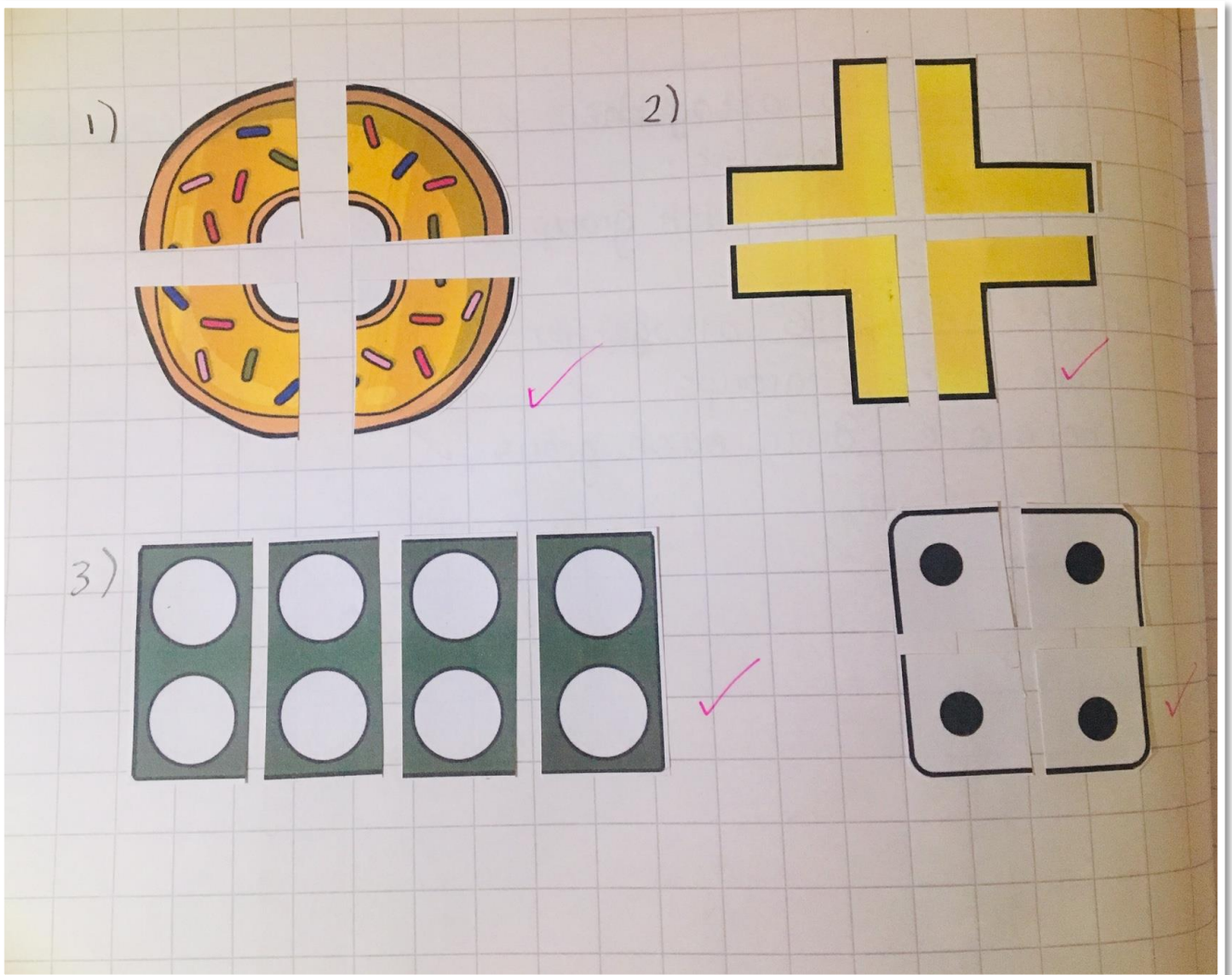
Children will split more complex pictorial representations into quarters that may only have one way of being quartered.
