

National SATS Tests and Assessment Results

We have been so pleased with and proud of our children this week. On Tuesday, we got the results back for the Year Six SATS tests and validation of our Year One Phonics results and Year Two assessments. They have all achieved so well. I must offer a big congratulations to them and a big thank you to all the staff.

Below is a table with a breakdown of this year's results showing the percentage of pupils reaching the expected standard compared with the national data from last year. This year's national data will not be available until September but it is generally pretty similar year on year.
