

The Friends of Kislingbury CE Primary School is a registered charity founded in 1996 by a group of parents passionate about raising vital funds to make the school a better place for their children.

What we do

Through the year the Friends run events such as Bingo nights, Disco's, film nights, Summer and Christmas fayres to raise money for much needed equipment. We occasionally organise evening and family events to bring the school and the village community together.

We also provide little extras at school events such as treats at the pantomime, ice lollies for sports day and crackers for the Christmas meal.



Ethos


Our ethos is to support the school and children in as many ways as possible.

Previous fundraising campaigns

Over the past few years the Friends of Kislingbury have donated equipment: purchasing cameras, audio equipment, a new stage for performances, rucksacks and sports uniforms used for school trips and tournaments, playground equipment, a quiet play and seated area, and a defibrillator.

Our school, Kislingbury CE Primary School

Kislingbury CE Primary School is a primary school in the South Northamptonshire area. This rural school has an intake of 149 pupils, from reception to year 6. In 2018 the school became an academy, which is part of the Peterborough Dioceses Education Trust.



The Fundraising Campaign for this school year (2019/2020)

For this school year, Friends of Kislingbury CE Primary school have been asked to fundraise for the replacement and supply of IT equipment.

Taking into account of the limited fleet of computers available in the school and its age, and considering the way that society and jobs are evolving (digitalisation, smart factories, smart cities etc.), Friends Of Kislingbury School will fundraise to purchase the following:

- 15 Mini i-Pad with chargers for KS1 and STEAM club (estimated amount needed £5,800)
- 20 re-conditioned laptops for KS2 coding and Design &
 Technology curricula (estimated amount needed £6,000)



The Fundraising Campaign for this school year (2019/2020)

As we are aware of the amount of funding that Friends of Kislingbury CE Primary School needs to collect to achieve this goal, the committee and members of Friends are putting on extra events this year, aside from Discos, Film nights and Sweet shops. Those extra events include:

- 1st February 2020: Charity Ball and Auctions (memorabilia have been donated from sport and motorsport local companies);
- March 2020: Gin tasting Night and raffle, helped by one of the local pubs;
- June 2020: school summer fete within the Kislingbury Flowerpot display village fayre (will include a bake off competition, traditional games, bingo, afternoon tea room etc).
