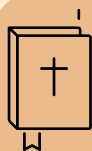

Reminders

READING

We encourage children to read 10 minutes per day. Teachers read to the children 10 minutes per day and having exposure to 20 minutes of reading per day has a significant impact on children's education. Any reading that is complete, please write and sign in your child's reading record.

UNIFORM

Please see uniform policy online if ever unsure.

A few reminders: children to wear suitable school shoes (not trainers). If a child is required to wear trainers then a signed note or phone call is required, rather than information passed from parent to child to teacher. Earrings must be a small plain stud - no designs or hoops.

PE

Our PE day will be **Tuesday** and **Thursday**. Please have PE kit (see uniform policy online if unsure) at the beginning of the term or at least every Monday. If any child does not have kit, then spares will be given so they do not miss out on this lesson. Please make sure hair is tied back and earrings are removed on these days.

HOMEWORK

Homework is handed out on Wednesdays and is collected on the following Tuesday. Please ensure all is completed.

Spellings: learn the spellings for the week and recap previous week's.

Maths: learn the maths facts and complete separate weekly focused maths work.

Any issues or problems with homework please contact your teacher and they are more than happy to help.

If homework is persistently forgotten or incomplete, a phone call may be made and time in reflection to catch up will take place.
