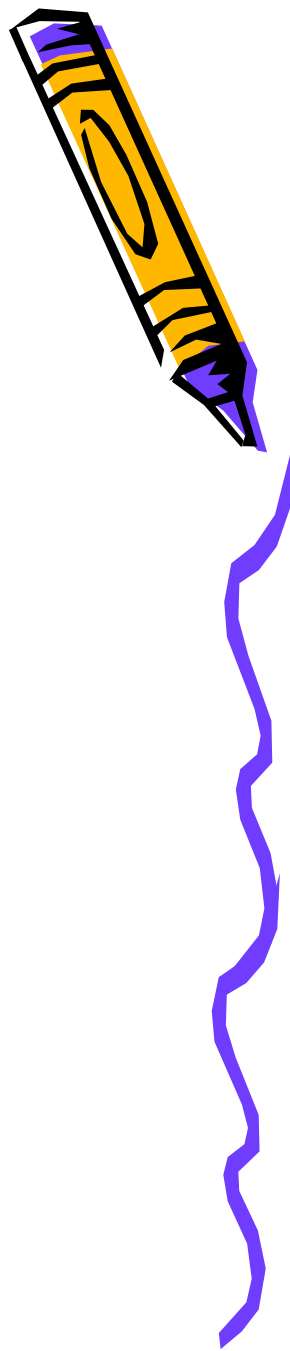


Learning Objective:

grapheme 'ou'.

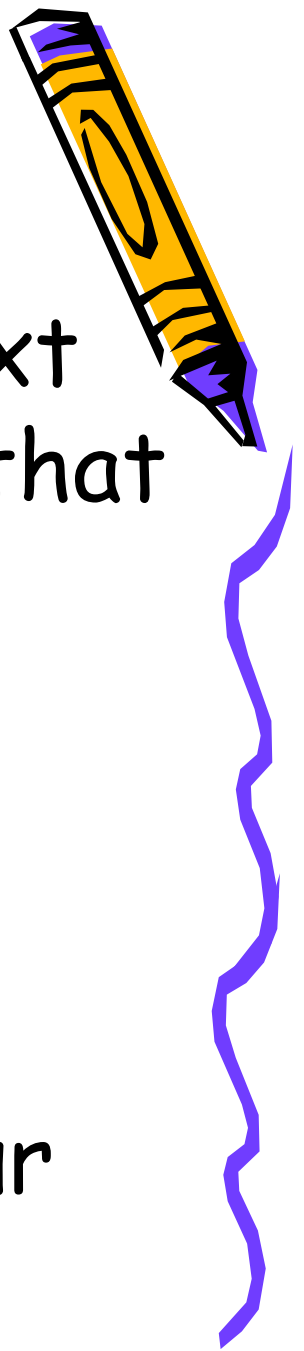


Revisit/ Review:

- ou is digraph.
- o and u join together to make ou.
- Makes the same sound as 'ow' - brown cow.



Note - we will look at this digraph making a different sound in a future lesson
