I have included my own version at the end of this Powerpoint to help you

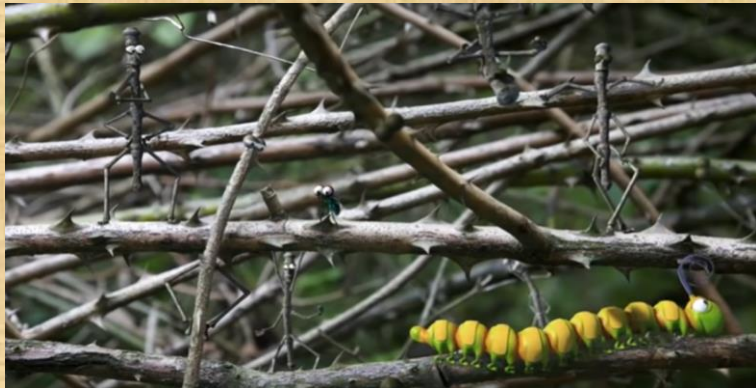
Think about:
