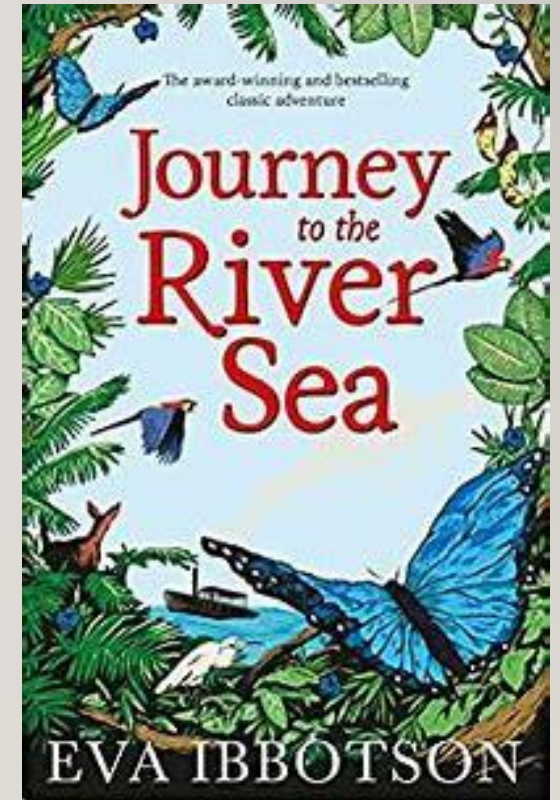


# BOOK TALK

\*Make sure that the object you are jumping over is fixed to the floor.

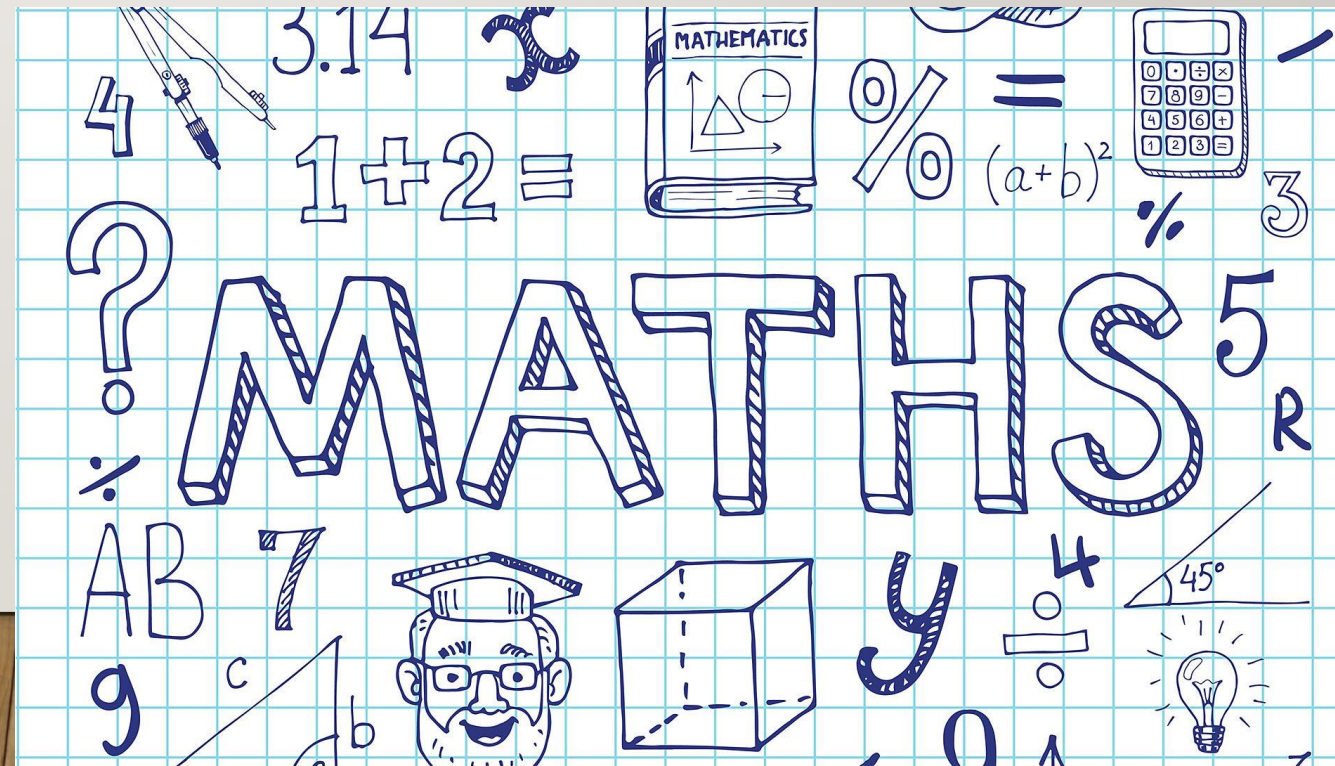

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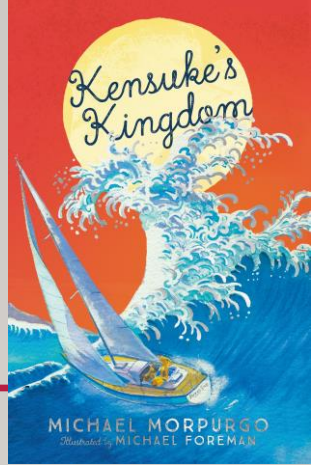

## 60 Second Challenge Burpees

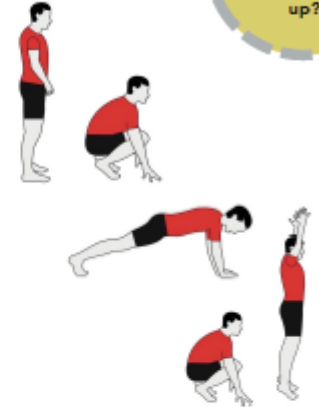
Do you keep trying even when you want to give up?

My sentence for today: FANTASTIC sentence – Inner Thoughts.

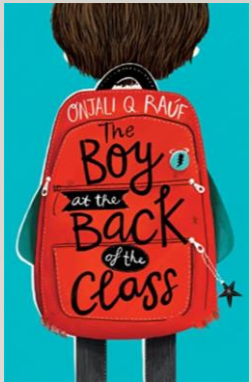
