- Use different reading skills to answer the questions. Remember to re-read the text to help.

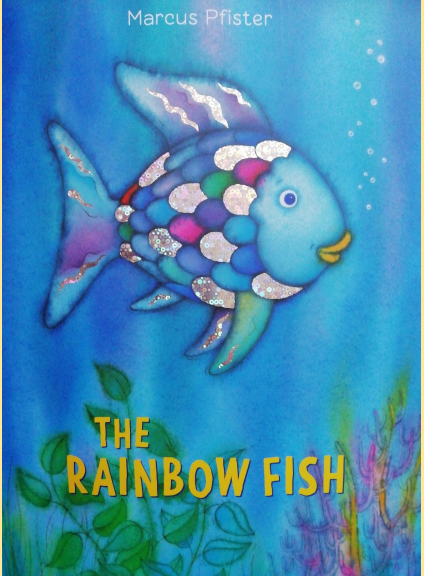

Never. How could I ever be happy without them?

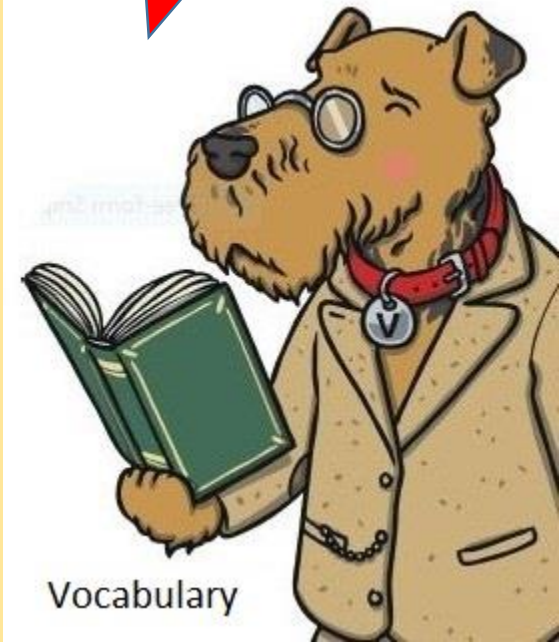


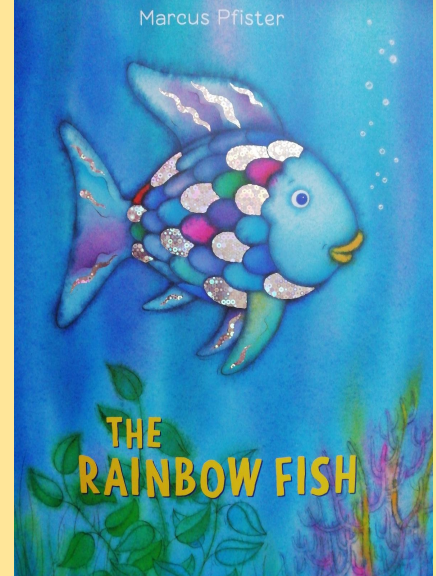
What is the octopus' advice?
