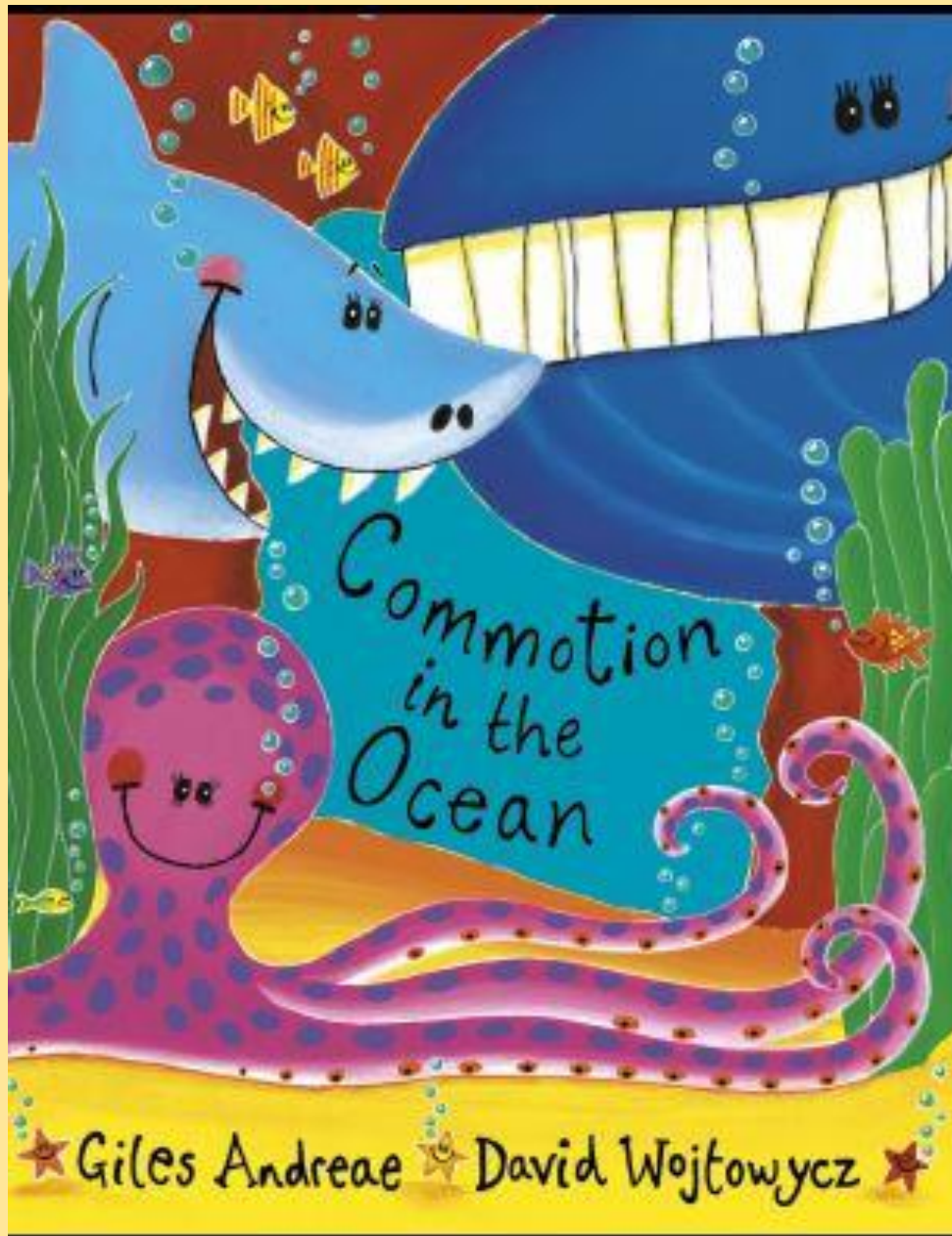


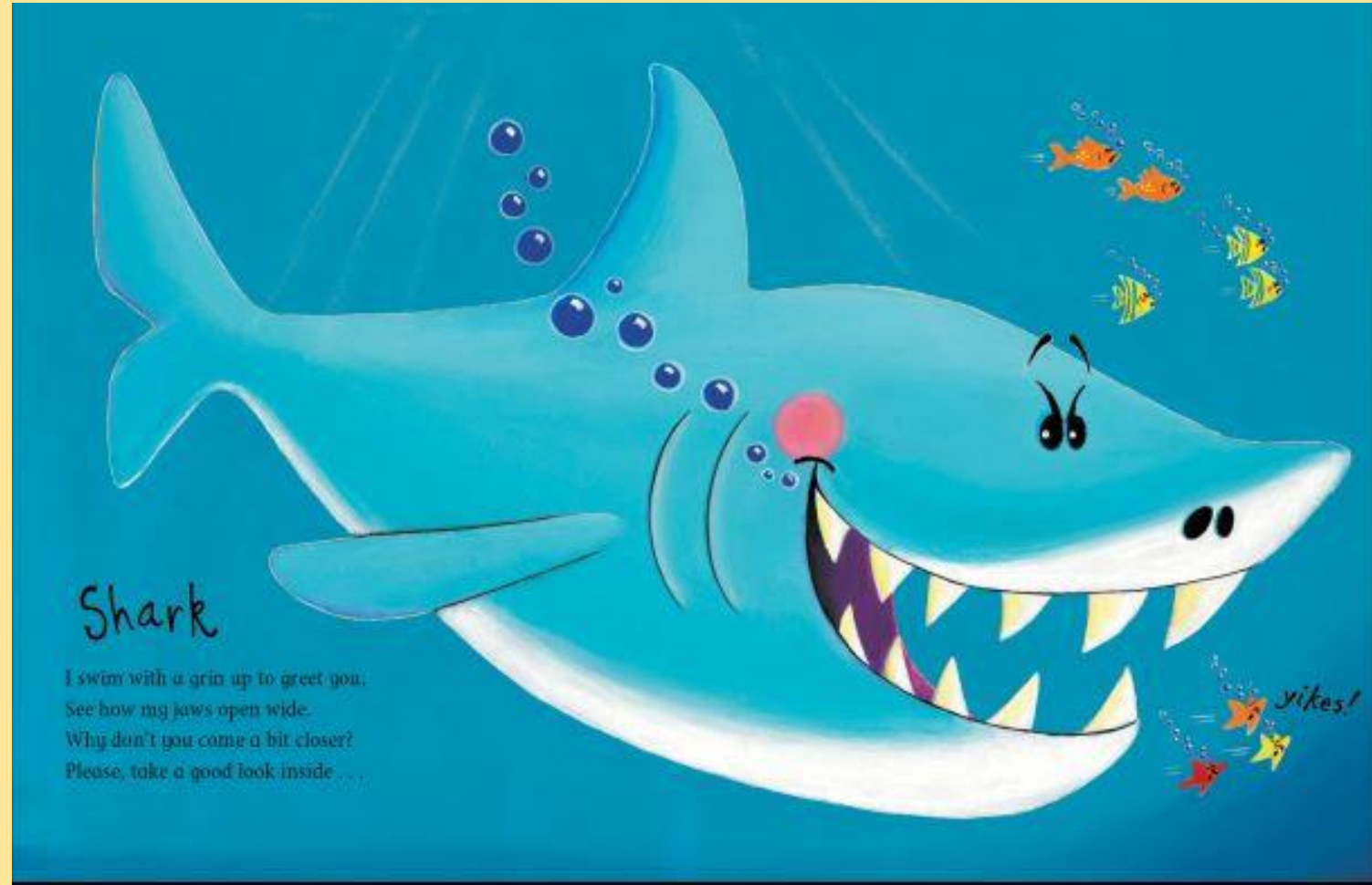


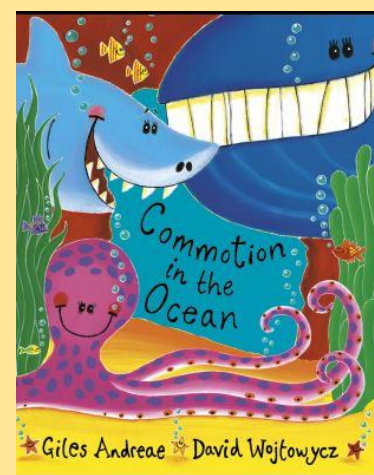
Read the pages from the story and then discuss the questions.

to swim closer?

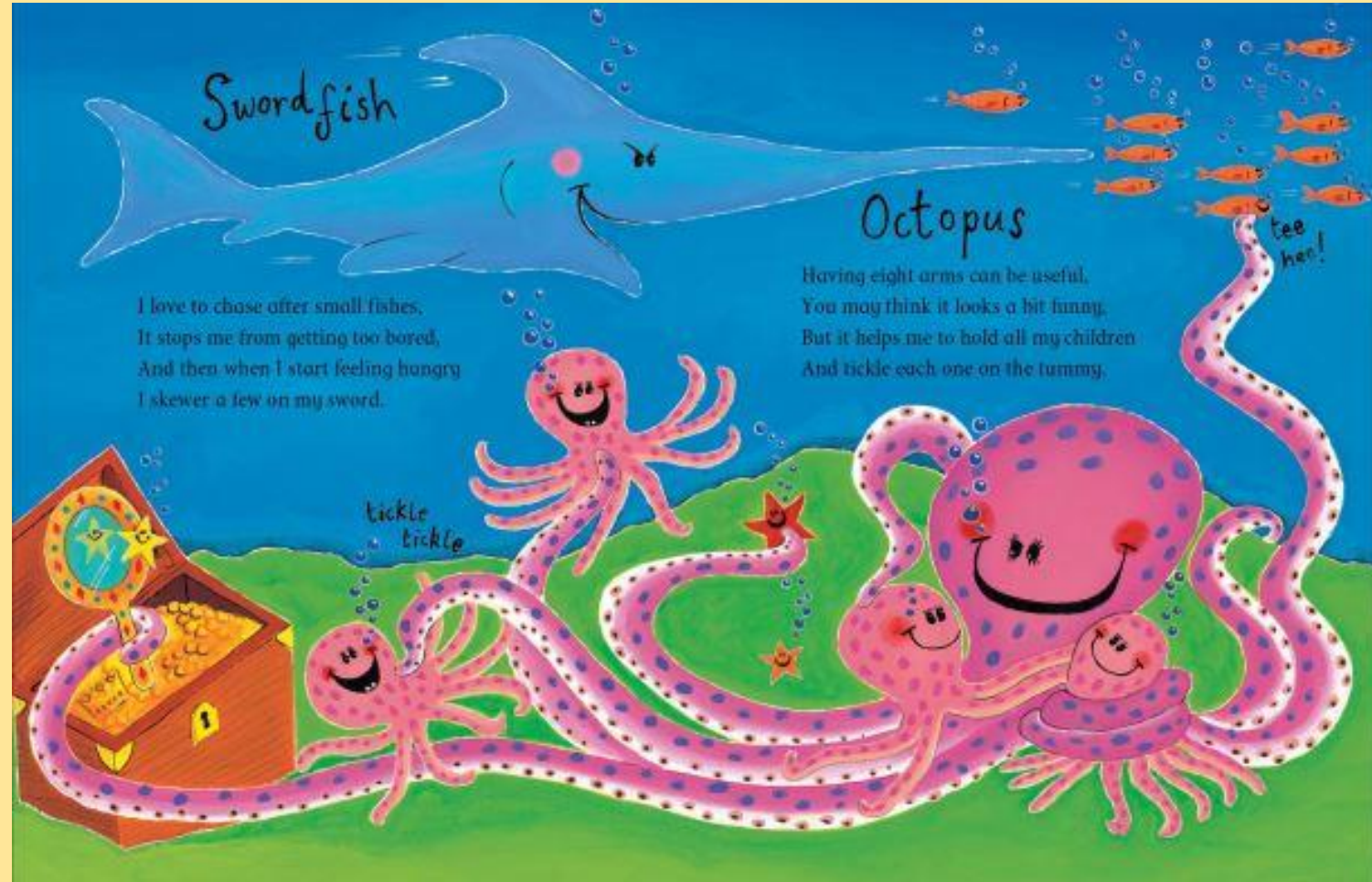


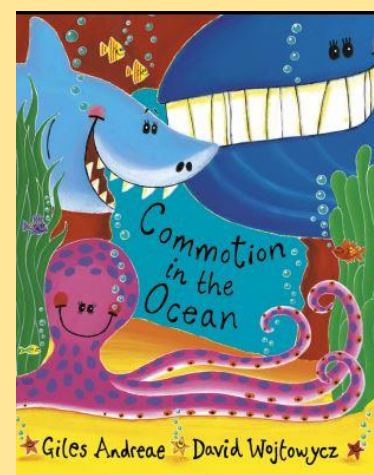
Swordfish
