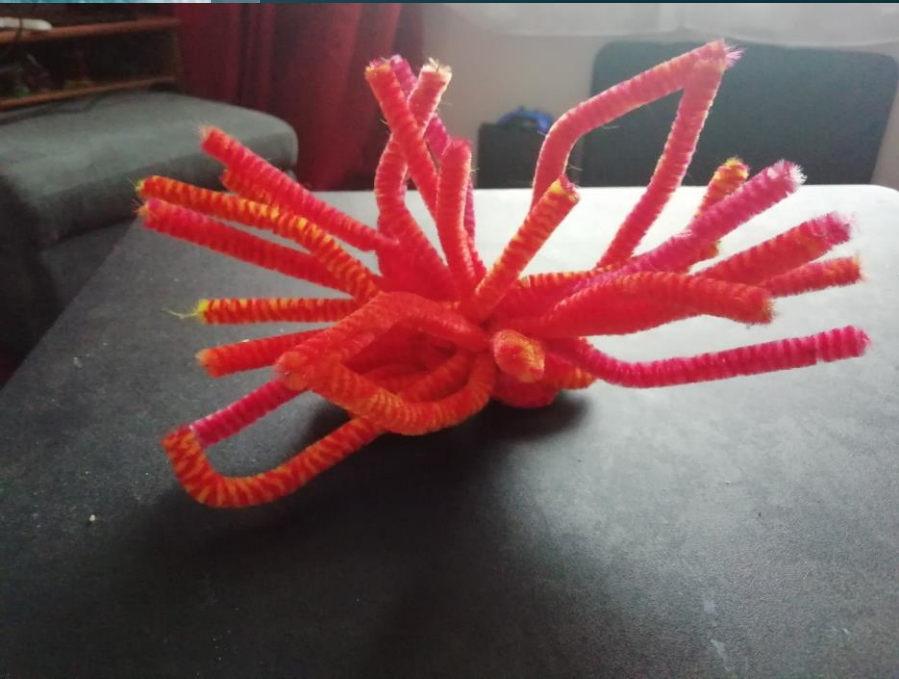
3D Sea Creatures



Can you make a 3D Model of a Sea Creature?

- A 3D Model is a model that can be held rather than just a picture.
- Your task this week is to make your own 3D sea creature out of your own choice of materials (toilet rolls, egg boxes, pipe cleaners, playdough, cereal boxes, pebbles, Lego ect)
- I have made some models to give you some ideas, but I am sure that your ideas will be a lot more creative than mine.

Pipe Cleaner Anemone

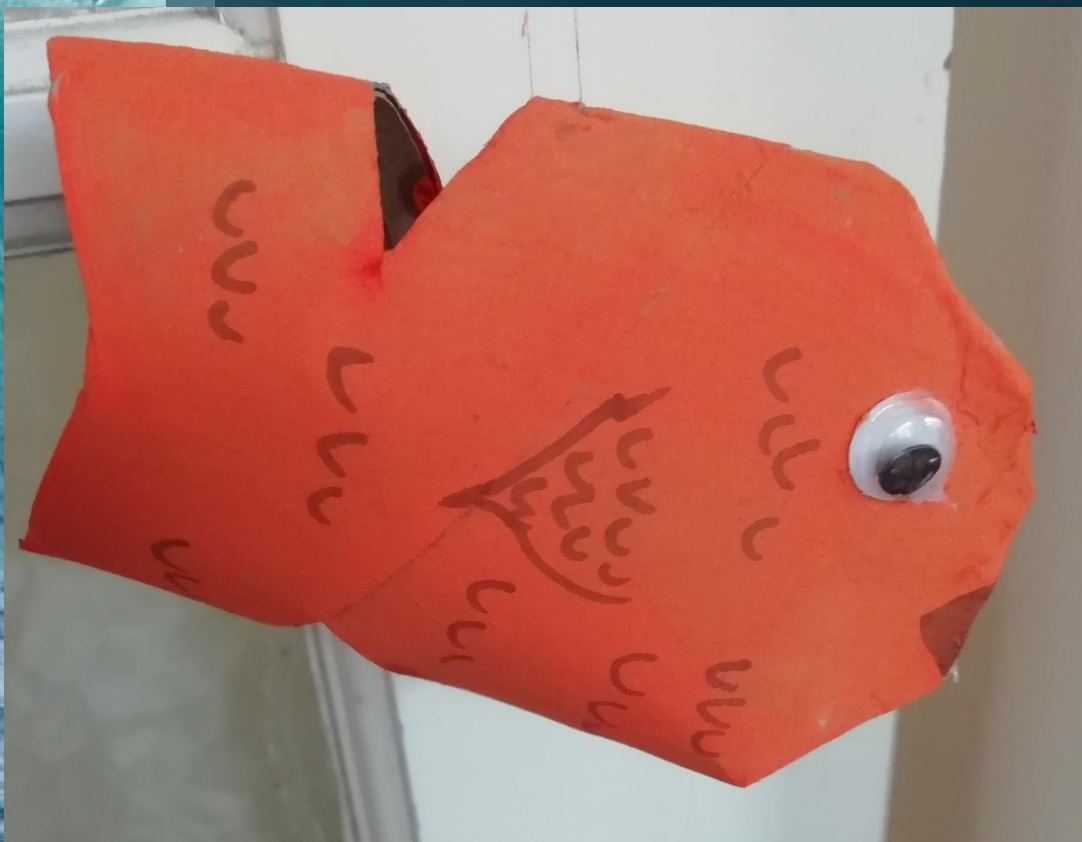


Playdough Starfish

Egg box and tissue jellyfish

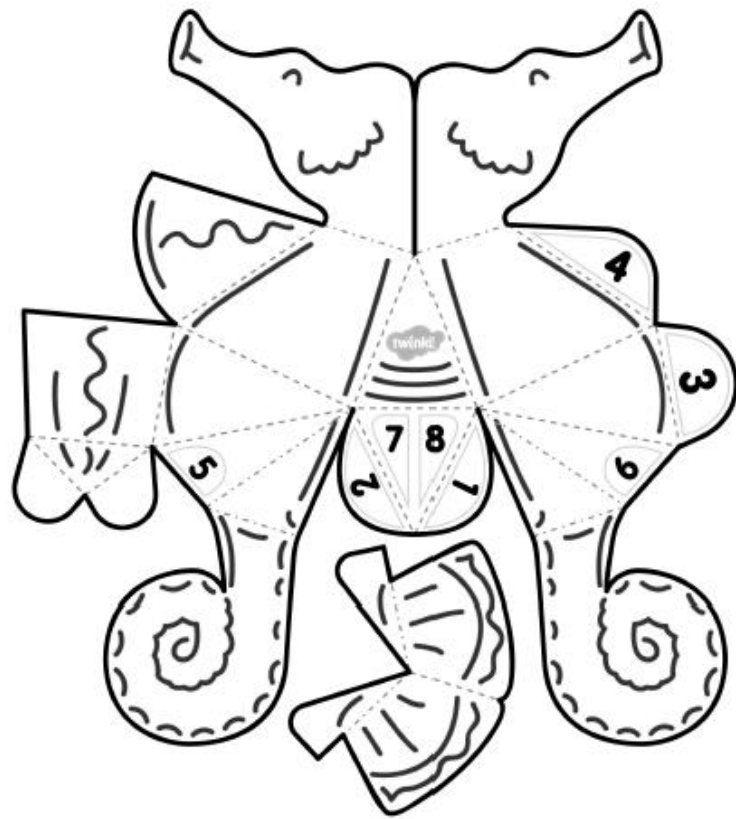


Toilet roll Fish and Octopus

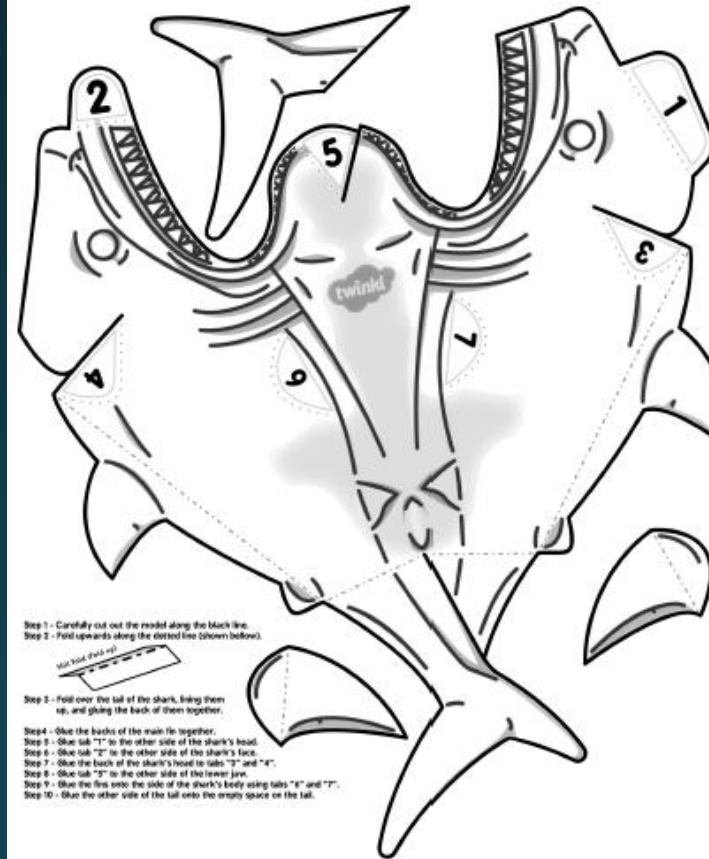


Or you could have a go at making one of the 3D paper models in the folder.

Seahorse Paper Model



Simple Shark Paper Model



Step 1 - Carefully cut out the model along the black line.
Step 2 - Fold upwards along the dotted line (shown below).



Step 3 - Fold over the tail of the shark, bring them up, and glue the back of them together.

Step 4 - Glue the backs of the main fin together.
Step 5 - Glue tab "1" to the other side of the shark's head.
Step 6 - Glue tab "2" to the other side of the shark's face.
Step 7 - Glue the back of the shark's head to tabs "3" and "4".
Step 8 - Glue tab "5" to the other side of the lower jaw.
Step 9 - Glue the fins onto the side of the shark's body using tabs "6" and "7".
Step 10 - Glue the other side of the tail onto the empty space on the tail.
