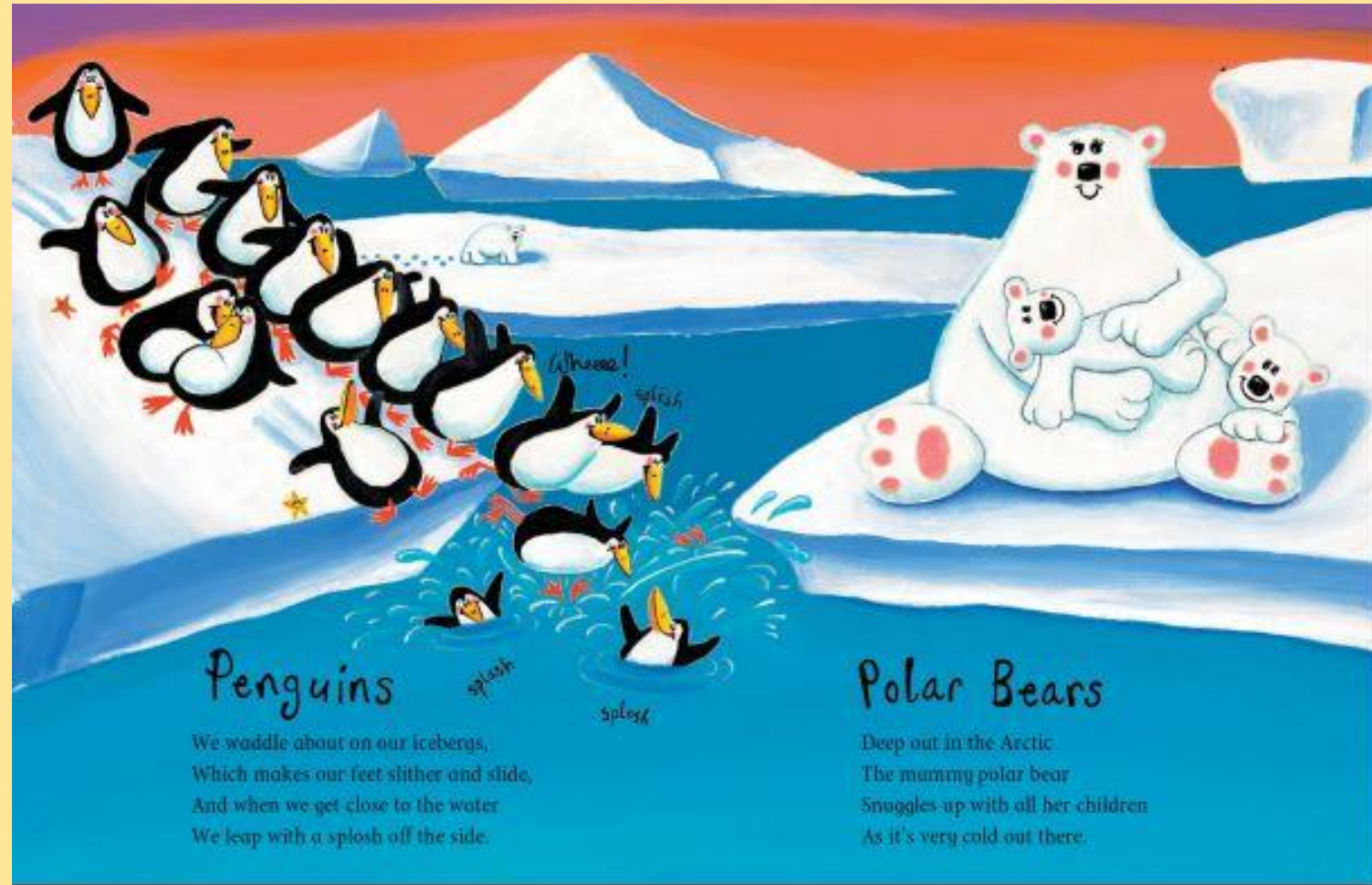
- Remember to use your phonics to sound out tricky words.

- Use different reading skills to answer the questions. Remember to re-read the text to help.

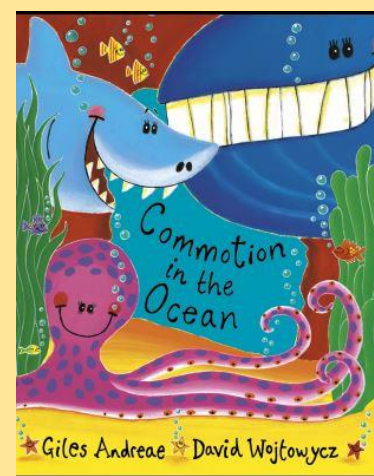
Penguins

this is called?

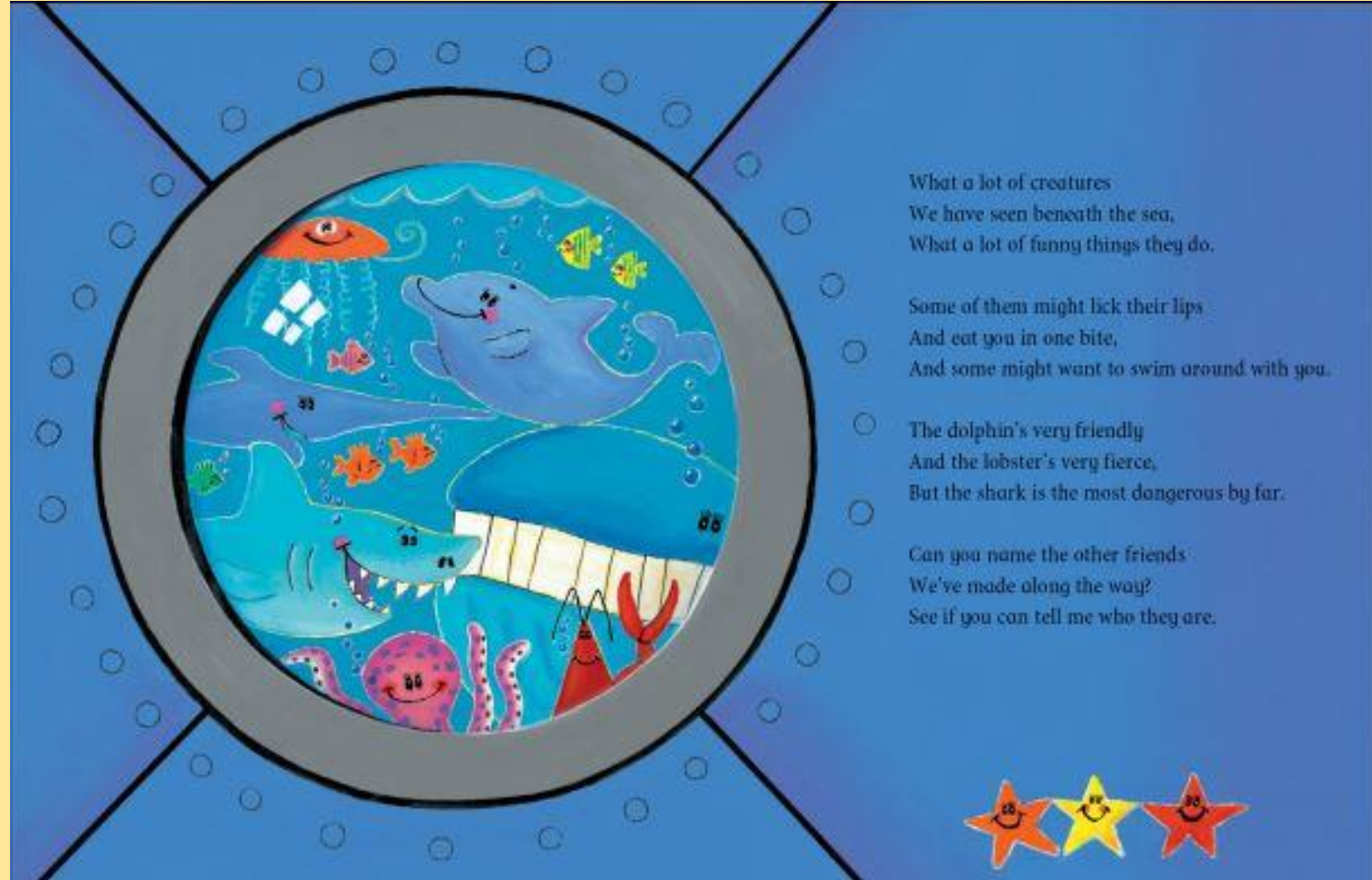


What a lot of creatures

See if you can tell me who they are.



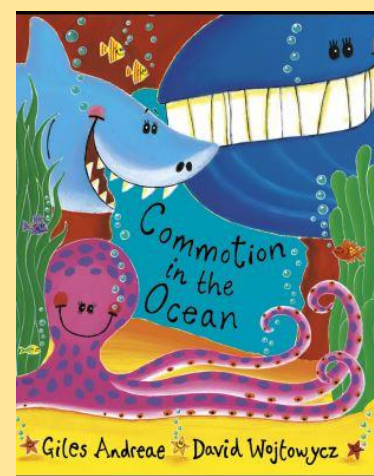
